Thank you for coming to this event which is being held to raise funds to fight for justice for Simon Jones. This leaflet tells you what is happening with the campaign at the moment. The judicial review and candlelit vigil

The judicial review into the Crown Prosecution Service's decision not to prosecute any individual or company in connection with Simon's death is scheduled to begin on Thursday 16th March. It will be the first ever judicial review into a workplace death. There will be a candlelit vigil outside the High Court in the Strand, London, from 8pm on the previous evening, Wednesday 15th March. We hope that a lot of people will come to the vigil, especially between 8.30pm and 9.30pm, to support our call for companies and bosses to be held accountable for the deaths caused by their pursuit of profit. Please bring a candle and a jar.

A coach will leave Brighton for the candlelit vigil from outside St Peters Church at 5pm and will return to Brighton by 1am that night. The cost of a place on the coach is £2. Please give your name, phone number and ticket money to the campaign stall if you want to book a place on the coach. If you know anyone from London or elsewhere who may want to go on the vigil please let them know and ask them to bring a candle and a jar.

Your purple ribbon

You should find a purple ribbon on your seat. This ribbon is a symbol of remembrance for people killed at work. We are asking you to wear the ribbon this evening and during the judicial review due to start on 16th March. You can of course wear it any time - it is traditionally worn on Workers' Memorial Day, 28th April.

Our new campaign video
